- Street Funds**– City received \$\$17,576.00 from Cass County for its share of the ¼ cent Road and Bridges Sales tax. These funds can only be used for streets. (See attached report)

 - **Building Codes** – Eric Atchley is working on building codes.
 - **Storm Siren** – Siren does work but does not rotate. Researching grants for replacing the siren.

13) **Parks and Recreation**

- Green Space** – discussed having a policy for using green space (buyout property) for laterals where homeowner would be responsible for maintenance.
- Weed eater** – Need to research replacing. Will be added to the April agenda.
- Mowing** – Need to revisit volunteer vs employees for mowing.

14) **Roads**

- Road Signs**– 2 Children at Play signs still need to be installed. Several citizens have complained about Board members not following speed limits.

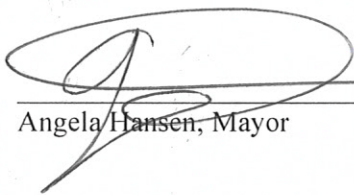

16) **Adjournment from Regular Meeting**

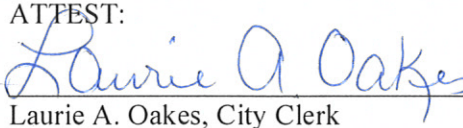
Motion: By Alderman Hart, second by Alderwoman Burns to adjourn the regular meeting.
