

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF LAKE ANNETTE MISSOURI CONSERNING POLLUTION

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen have determined that it is in the best interest of the residents of Lake Annette, Missouri to protect the lake, ponds and any other property under the control of the city from pollution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Lake Annette, Missouri, as follows:

Section 1: It shall be unlawful for any person to pollute any lake or pond water in any way or dump trash or litter on any property under the control of the City of Lake Annette.

Section 2: That a copy of this resolution shall be kept on file in the office of the City Clerk.

Section 3: That all ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4: Effective Date. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
