

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF LAKE ANNETTE MISSOURI BY THE ADDITION OF CHAPTER 260: AIR QUALITY STANDARDS AND AIR POLLUTION CONTROL TO THE CODES OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF LAKE ANNETTE, MISSOURI.

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen have determined that it is in the best interest of the residents of Lake Annette, Missouri to protect air quality standards.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Lake Annette, Missouri, as follows:

Section 1: Chapter 260: Air quality Standards and Air Pollution Control, shall be added to the Codes or Ordinances of the City of Lake Annette, Missouri as follows:

Section 260.010: DEFINITIONS

Untreated Wood: Lumber and other wooden materials that have not been chemically treated for resistance to moisture, fire, fungi, insects, and other pests or has not otherwise been treated or manufactured with chemicals, or that does not contain adhesives or resins. Untreated wood does not include plywood, particle board, chipboard, or wood with other than minimal amounts of paint, coating, or finish.

Yard Waste: Trees, tree leaves, brush, or any other type of vegetation.

Household Refuse: Solid waste produced by routine household activities, such as paper waste and garbage from daily activities. Does not include home remodeling wastes, wastes from home businesses, durable goods such as old appliances, carpets or furniture, tires, or other non-routine household waste.

Section 260.020. OPEN BURNING

Any waste generated by a business, trade, industry, salvage, or demolition operation cannot be burned without a permit issued by the Department of Natural Resources or its delegated local agency. Permits will only be considered for untreated wood wastes. Wastes that may not be burned include but not limited to tires, rubber products, hazardous materials, Styrofoam, plastics, petroleum-based products, demolition waste, treated wood and any asbestos-containing material.

Section 260.030: BURNING OF HOUSEHOLD REFUSE

Burning of household refuse is prohibited.

Section 260.040: BURNING PROHIBITED DURING WINDS ABOVE 15 MPH AND RED FLAG DAYS.

Burning when winds are above 15 mph and on red flag days is prohibited.

Section 260.050: HOURS FOR OPEN BURNING

Open burning shall take place only between sunrise and 9:00 p.m.

Section 260.060: BURNING OF TREE TRUNKS, TREE LIMBS, LEAVES VEGETATION

Open burning of yard waste is allowed from sites provided it originates and is burned on the same premises or a City designated location. All open burning must be attended. Materials such as tires or used oil may not be used to start the fires or be burned in the fires.

Section 260.070: FIRES FOR RECREATIONAL PURPOSES

Fires used for recreational purposes, or fires used for the non-commercial preparation of food such as by barbecuing is not in violation of this ordinance.

Section 260.080: BURNING OS ASPHALT, RUBBER OR PETROLEUM BASED PRODUCTS PROHIBITED.

It shall be unlawful to burn any asphalt, rubber, or petroleum-based products such as; but not limited to, tires, shingles, carpeting or motor oil.

Section 260.090: BURNING FOR PURPOSES OF FIRE DISTRICT TRAINING

Burning for the purpose of training fire fighters, provided they are conducted in accordance with National Fire Protection Associations Standards 600 and 1403 is allowed.

Section 260.100: PENALTIES

Any Person, persons, organized group, association, or legal entity who shall violate the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined \$100.00.

Section 2: That a copy of this resolution shall be kept on file in the office of the City Clerk.

Section 3: That all ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4: Effective Date. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
