

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF LAKE ANNETTE, MISSOURI ACCEPTING THE CANDIDATES FOR THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN**

**WHEREAS** on November 30, 2024 the Board of Aldermen called for a Municipal Election to be held on April 2, 2024 two Aldermen at Large for a term of two (2) years; and

**WHEREAS**, Qualified Candidates were given the opportunity to file between December 5, 2023 and December 26, 2023; and

**WHEREAS**, Edna Burns and Robert Lampkin was the only qualified candidates to file for the office of Alderman at Large; and

**WHEREAS**, On April 2, 2019 the voters of City of Lake Annette authorized the City of Lake Annette to forgo annual elections if the number of candidates who have filed for office is equal to the number of positions in the office to be filled by the election.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FREEMAN AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1** The Board of Aldermen does find that Edna Burns and Robert Lampkin. are the candidates for Aldermen at Large and each shall hold the office for two years, until a successor is duly elected or appointed and qualified according to law.

**SECTION 2** That a copy of this ordinance shall be kept on file in the office of the City Clerk.

**SECTION 3** That all ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 4** The effective date of this Ordinance shall be the 17<sup>th</sup> day of April 2024






